RULES OF COMPETITION

1. The Competition is open to Members of Clubs in the Grampian North Area affiliated to the Scottish Association of Young Farmers' Clubs. No club may put forward more than three teams, including an "All Ladies" team.
2. Entries close on 2nd JULY, 2022 and must be made to the Secretary on the attached Entry Form.
3. Entry Money for each Team is £1, to be paid at time of entry.
4. Competitors are forbidden to communicate with each other or with any other person during the competition, under penalty of disqualification.
5. In the event of a tie, the teams may be called on to give reasons for the placing of one class of Stock.
6. The decision of the Judges and Committee shall be final.
7. All orders by the Committee must be obeyed.
8. Each Competitor shall judge five classes of stock. The Competition shall commence at 12 noon until 2 pm on Sunday, 17th July 2022. Competitors will assemble at Y.F.C. Caravan.

RULES

1. Entries and display must be set up in marquee on Saturday, 16th July between the hours of 9 a.m. and 10 a.m. and must be uplifted between 3.00 p.m. and 3.45 p.m. on Sunday, 17th July.
2. Only two members of each club may be present to arrange exhibits, of which one may be an associate member.
3. Space allowed to each club is 5ft. length, plain white background will be provided. A maximum of 10 points will be awarded for each article, plus 10 points for display (which will be judged first).
4. **Every care will be taken of the exhibits, but members of the Association will not be held responsible for any damage or loss.**
5. Entry to be returned to the Secretary not later than 2nd July, 2022.
