## **RULES**

1. The exhibition is open to all comers.
2. THE JUDGES DECISION SHALL BE FINAL AND BINDING.
3. All exhibits must be bone fide work of the exhibitor in whose name the entry is made and must have been worked since 16th July 2023.
4. Each article for the competition must have the exhibitors name and contact details printed in a sealed envelope, securely attached. Section and class number only to be written on the outside of the envelope, unless otherwise stated. Failure to do this could result in the exhibitor not receiving their prize money.
5. Sections 6 and 7 (all classes), Age and/or Primary class should be written on the outside of the envelope.
6. An entry fee of 30p per exhibit, to be paid at the door of the marquee, with the exception of Section 7(children under 12) and Section 9 which are free.
7. Exhibitors are allowed TWO entries in each Class in Section 8 (horticulture) and Section 1 (flowers and foliage). All others are limited to ONE per Class.
8. Knitted articles must be shown unwashed. Sewn articles may be washed.
9. No vases or containers are provided for Section 8, classes 20-38.
10. Every care will be taken exhibits, but Members of the Committee do not hold themselves responsible for any loss or damage.
11. Exhibits will be received in the marquee between 8am and 10am on Saturday 20th July 2024.
12. NO EXHIBITS TO BE LIFTED FROM THE TABLES BEFORE 3.30PM BUT MUST BE COLLECTED BEFORE 4PM. No exhibit to be removed by the stewards before 4pm. Please ensure you ONLY remove your own exhibits on SUNDAY 21st JULY 2024.
13. Any food item remaining after 4pm on Sunday 21st July 2024 will be disposed of appropriately.
14. Two prizes will be given in each Class as shown in a Section, a third will be awarded where justified by number of entries and merit.
15. In points competitions a first prize shall count for 3 points, a second prize 2 points and a third prize 1 point.
16. Prize money will be paid in the Industrial tent on SATURDAY and SUNDAY between 2 and 4pm. Any uncollected prize money will be returned to the Secretaries Office on Sunday 21st July 2024.
17. Any joint trophy winners should arrange to share the time for the trophy following the presentation at the prize giving.
